Compact Fluorescent Lamps Save You Money!!!

Did you know that compact fluorescent lamps (CFLs) use about one-fourth the energy of traditional incandescent light bulbs? For example, a 20-watt CFL produces the same amount of light that a typical 75-watt incandescent bulb does. Because CFLs deliver the same amount of light and use less energy you save money on your electric bill. While the initial purchase price of a CFL is higher, it lasts about 10 times longer than an incandescent bulb, and you're not changing light bulbs as often. At KPU Electric's current rate, for every bulb you install you will save \$50.88 over the 10,000-hour life of the bulb.
