Government-Funded Energy Programs Can Save You Money!!!

If you meet eligibility requirements, you may be able to receive weatherization improvements including storm windows, additional insulation and heating system improvements.

How It Works

The U.S. Department of Energy funds a Weatherization Assistance Program, which is administered for our state by the Alaska Housing Finance Corporation. The AHFC oversees the local agencies that perform the field work. Program operators install energy-efficient improvements in qualifying households (single frame houses and mobile homes).
